Last year income was £79,000 expenses £83,000, in 2019/20 the comparable figures will be about £52,000 and £43,000, showing a small surplus (incl £8,000 grant from Sports England)	Richard to finalise accounts – happy to continue – thank you

Should have 25-30 year life and significantly reduce annual electricity and maintenance bills from £11,000 to about £4,000.
